Attention: All Stakeholders

Reference our earlier Notice dated 16th November, 2007 published in 125 newspapers dated 24th November, 2007 in different languages in the country, under Sub-Section (1) of Section 10 and Section 13D of the Working Journalists and Other Newspaper Employees (Conditions of Service) and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1955, inviting all newspaper establishments, working journalists, non-journalist newspaper employees, including news agency employees, and persons interested in fixation or revision of rates of wages of Working Journalists and Non-Journalist Newspaper Employees, to make representations in writing. Subsequently, the last date for submission of representations was extended up to 30 June, 2008.

Further, based on the requests received from various stakeholders, the Chairman, National Wage Boards had agreed to extend the time period for sending representations under Sub-section (1) of Section 10 read with Section 13 D of the Working Journalists and Other Newspaper Employees (Conditions of Service) and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1955 till 31st October, 2008.

A number of representations have since been received from Unions of Working Journalists and Other Newspaper Employees requesting for further extension of time upto 28th February, 2009 in order to enable them to submit representations in the matter. The Hon'ble Members of both the National Wage Boards have since been consulted in the matter and it has been decided with their consent to extend the last date for submission of representations upto 28th February, 2009.
