Sir,

I am directed to convey sanction of the President for incurring expenditure not exceeding **Rs. 36.88 lakh (Rs. Thirty Six lakh Eighty Eight Thousand only)** for procurement of Furniture for New and Existing ITIs in the State of TRIPURA under the scheme "Establishment of Industrial Training Institutes (ITI s) in North-Eastern States and Sikkim" during the Financial Year 2004-2005.

2. I am also directed to release an amount of **Rs. 29.50 lakh (Rs. Twenty Nine lakh & Fifty Thousand only)** for purchase of Furniture for New & Existing ITIs.

3. The release of Central fund of **Rs. 29.50 lakh (Rs. Twenty Nine lakh & Fifty Thousand only)** for purchase of Furniture in respect of the said scheme is subject to the following conditions :

(i) The equipment purchased should be strictly in accordance with the standard list of tools and equipment, as prescribed by NCVT for the particular trade or as per the list prescribed under "Project 150" of CSTARI, Calcutta for Short Term Courses under the approved scheme.

(ii) The grant shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned and no portion of it shall be spent on any other item.

(iii) The amount sanctioned should be utilized within a period of one year from the date of issue of the sanction and any amount not spent by that time should be surrendered to the Central Government.

(iv) The Utilisation Certificate in Form GFR 19-A indicating component-wise expenditure under the scheme should be furnished to the Directorate General in Duplicate.

(v) After making purchases, bid documents, bids, bid evaluation reports and letter of award should be retained by the State Directorate for post-award review by DGE&T (CPIU).


