Subject: Sanction for civil works in 5 ITIs in the State of Kerala under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "Upgradation of training infrastructure in 100 Govt. ITIs".

Sir,

In continuation to the sanction of even number dated 29.03.2006, wherein sanction was accorded for an amount of Rs. 147.30 lakhs, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to incur an additional expenditure not exceeding **Rs. 17.70 lakh (Rupees Seventeen Lakh Seventy Thousand only)** by the State Government of Kerala, as central share for the remaining civil work i.e. providing air-conditioners and generator sets in the ITIs covered under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) of 'Upgradation of training infrastructure in 100 Govt. ITIs'. The remaining 25% towards the cost will be borne by the State Govt. as per MOU signed between the Central & the State Government. The proposal related to civil works of the 5 ITIs was submitted by the Director of Industrial Training, Kerala vide their letter No.12/2/10306/5 dated 7.02.2006 and subsequent letter No. 1-2/10306 /05(2) dated 10.05.2007.

I am now directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for release of 75% of the central share amounting to **Rs. 13.27 lakh (Rupees Thirteen Lakh Twenty Seven Thousand only)** towards first and second installment to the State Government of Kerala, as tabulated below, under the CSS :

2. The release of Central fund of **Rs.13.27 lakhs** to the State Government of Kerala in respect of the said scheme is subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The ITIs should be renovated or constructed in accordance with the NCVT approved space norms and estimates prepared by CPWD/PWD or State approved agency.
- (ii) The grant shall be utilized keeping in view the guidelines of the Scheme/ MoU and only for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned and no portion of it shall be spent on any other item.
- (iii) The grant should be utilized within a period of one year from the date of issue of the sanction and any amount not spent by that time should be surrendered to the Central Government.
- (iv) IMC clearance must be obtained before initiating bidding/tendering for civil works.
- (v) The work shall be awarded after open competition / bidding / tendering through PWD / State approved agency.

- (vi) The Utilisation Certificate in Form GFR 19-A in respect of individual ITI indicating expenditure under the scheme should be furnished to the DGE&T in Duplicate.
3. The sanction relates to Plan Expenditure and is in accordance with the pattern of assistance approved by the Planning Commission and Ministry of Finance.
4. The expenditure is debitable to the Major Head "3601" during FY 2007-2008

Hence central share of Rs. 17.70 lakhs is being sanctioned which is 75% of the fund requirement of Rs. 23.60 lakh [ Rs. 3.60 lakh is available under 'civil works' and Rs. 20 lakh after reallocation from equipment'] for procurement of AC's and generator sets in accordance with the estimates in 5 ITIs covered under CSS, forwarded vide letter No.12/2/10306/5 dated 7.02.2006. **Also, while submitting the proposal for release of further funds, he is requested to furnish :**
  - the Utilisation Certificate of the installment in form GFR 19A
  - documentary evidence / photographs indicating progress of works or sample survey by DGE&T.
  - actual expenditure statement for the works in individual ITI, in case civil work gets completed by the time, so as to enable DGE&T to consider release of balance funds.
